#### Consensus Items

- CTPs may have multiple horizon year forecasts/deficiencies
- CTP projects may have cost estimates using SPOT On!ine cost estimator
- CTPs may have rough revenue projections at each horizon year
  - NCARPO to draft methodology NEED SUBCOMMITTEE
  - i.e. 10% Regional funds + 20% Division funds for horizon year
- CTP projects should be subject to funding analysis/fiscal realism
  - Not fiscal constraint, project-level limit, not program-level limit
  - i.e. CTP project cost shouldn't exceed funding projection
  - Opportunity for serious funding discussion with RTCC/RTAC

#### Items Under Consideration

- CTP process and format should be FLEXIBLE to meet local needs
- Plan, not Maps with Technical Report
  - May need to discuss with your BOT member(s)
- Reorganize CTP table of contents, for example:
  - Intro
  - Vision, Goals, Objectives/Performance Measures
  - Community Profile (Demographics, Land Use, Environmental)
  - Transportation Network (all modes) & Deficiencies
  - Recommendations
  - Appendices (Project Cut Sheets, Public Engagement, Forecast Methodologies, Alternatives Analysis, etc)

### Items Under Consideration

- Goals/Objectives
- Scoping Checklist, Steering Committee decides CTP components/options
- Regional CTPs
- RPOs draft Community Profile instead of Community Understanding Report
- Mapping

#### Fiscal Realism

- 1. TPB has agreed to do cost estimates
- 2. Statewide Plan says \$16B for TIP construction (2011-2040)
- 3. MPOs have fiscally constrained plans with funding projections
- 4. RPOs want fiscal realism
- 5. Recommendation from TPB/Programming
  - NCARPO should approve methodology
  - Estimated funding projections should have highway/non-highway control totals
  - 2040 Plan numbers should remain until Statewide Plan is updated
  - If planning horizon is 2045 or beyond, revenues can be projected
